## Anthology Author Agreement

The following terms and conditions outline the agreement between you (Contributor) and Dreaming Rabbit Press Co. (Publisher) to include your submitted work in the below defined Anthology. Please read through the following terms and conditions carefully. Returning the agreement signed constitutes as understanding and acceptance of the terms below.

### I. Description of Work

- A. Publisher will release an Anthology for sale which will include various written and visual works.
- B. The Anthology will be sold in both electronic and physical format.

### II. Copyright Usage

- A. Contributor grants publication of work by Publisher within the above listed Anthology only, to be sold world wide.
- B. The Anthology as a whole may be licensed to other publishers or companies for translations into foreign language or audio editions.
- C. The Anthology may be included in certain non-profit organizations for the handicapped.
- D. Publisher owns exclusive rights to publish for six months within the Anthology. After six months, Publisher will continue to release the Anthology without exclusive rights to the work.
- E. Contributor agrees to not publish or submit this work prior to release of Anthology for a period of six months after publication of the Anthology.
- F. Parts and or quotes of works may be used in promotional material for the Anthology by the Publisher.
- G. Rights not specifically defined in this agreement are reserved by Author.
- H. Attribution to the Contributor shall be found in the front matter of the Anthology as well as with the Contributor's work.

### III. Liability

- A. Dreaming Rabbit Press Co will not be held responsible for accusations of theft or plagiarism made against the Contributor.
- B. Contributor represents and warrants that they hold the rights to the work, and that to the best of the Contributor's knowledge, the work does not contain any libelous material and is not in violation of any rights of privacy or any other rights of third persons, and does not violate any existing common law or statutory copyrights.
- C. In the event of a copyright claim against the Contributor, work will be removed from the Anthology and the Contributor will be responsible for damages. This includes payments made to Contributor in addition to a kill fee equal to the Anthology's projected earnings over on year plus cost of production.
- D. If the Publisher fails to publish the Anthology within two months of this agreement being signed, all rights revert back to the Contributor.

### IV. Payment

- A. Contributor will be paid a single payment for their work, as stated above.
- B. Payments shall be made through Online Services such as Paypal or Square. Publisher will cover all fees.
- C. Publisher will provide one digital and one print copy of the Anthology at no cost, to the Contributor. Additional copies may be purchased directly from the Publisher for a 30% discount.

### V. Complete Agreement

- A. This agreement is the entire agreement of all parties. Additional promises or conditions must be made by creating a new contract.
- B. The findings of any provision of this agreement to be invalid or unenforceable does not render the remaining provisions invalid or unenforceable.
- C. Contract will be notarized by notary program online to ensure validity. Publisher and Contributor must retain a copy of the contract.
